3.3 Option : additionnal fixation kit ref. number 0 880 95 (example : plaster)

Allow floor clamping when it is necessary for a raised floor in brittle material such as plaster, for which the fixation type with clips of the frame support is not convenient (clamps may be not fixed sufficiently in the plaster)

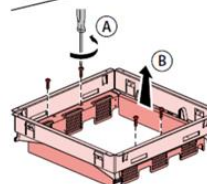
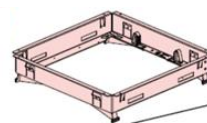

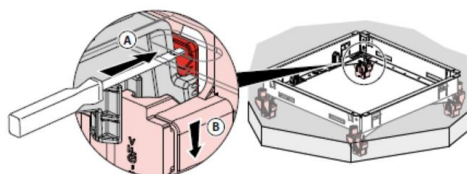
In case of adjustable horizontal support, unscrew the 4 screws (A) to remove grid (B). Do the opposite operation, once the 4 fixations are installed

3.3.3 Fixations installation

After the assembly of the frame in the floor (cf. 3.2), clip the fixations to the 4 red brackets in the corners of the floor box frame

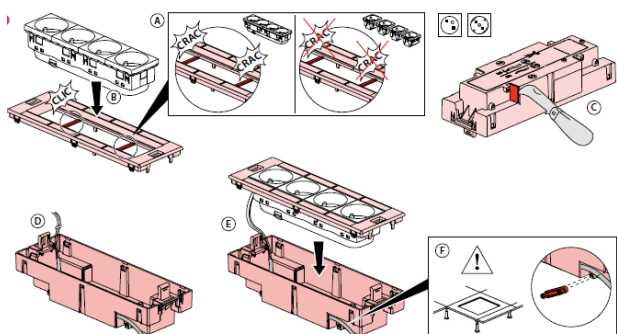

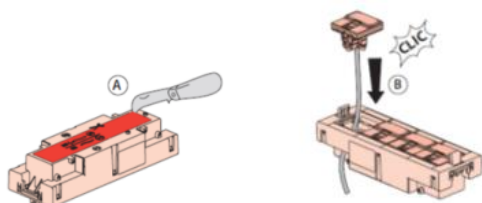
▪ 2P+E sockets only :

- Clip the sockets in the support (figure B) (in case of unitary sockets DO NOT BREAK the trigger guards (figure A))
- remove side cap (figure C)
- pass the cable through the entry (figure D)
- cable the sockets and clip the whole into the basket (figure E)
- screw cable with cable clip (figure F)

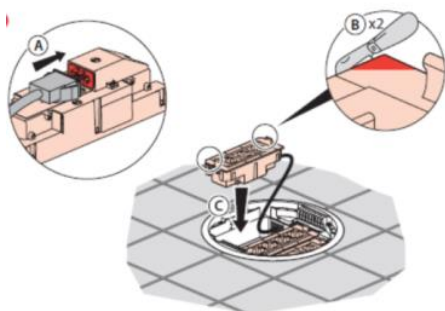


▪ For DATA sockets only :

- the lateral cable entries can be used OR an arrival of cables from the bottom is possible :
- remove the inferior part (figure A)
- connect the mechanisms (figure B)

4.3 Finishing plates

Use our finishing plates or another coating : depth will not exceed 8 mm

Remove the double sided adhesive tape (A)

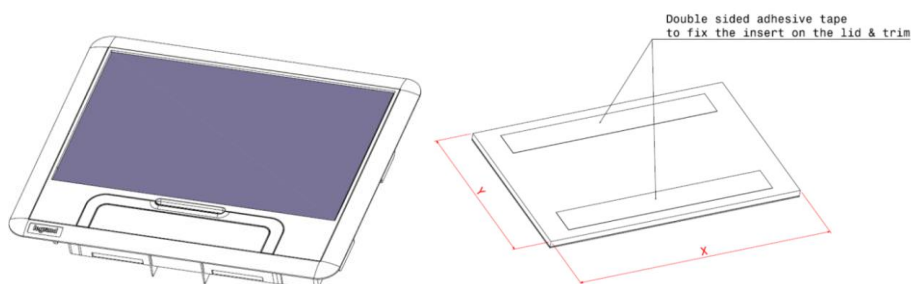

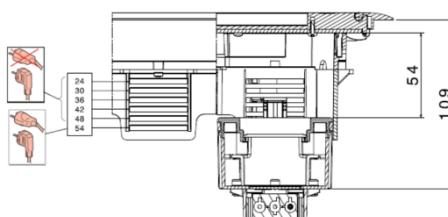

Fast connecting system



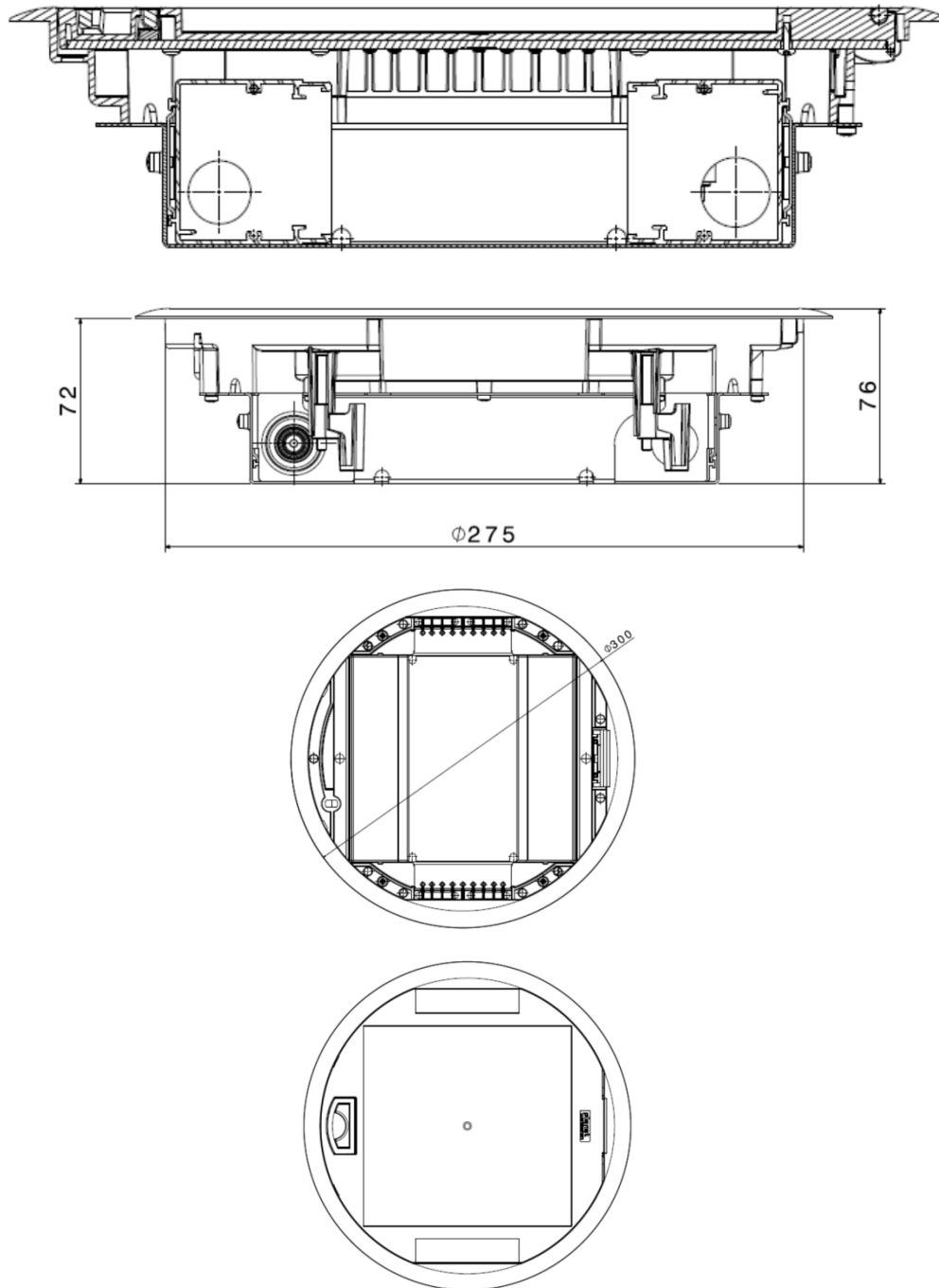
Dimensions (mm) of the different positions of the module
